

Local Auckland Details

Auckland City has long been rated among the best in the world for quality of life, as it combines the sophistication of a world-class cosmopolitan city with extraordinary natural wonders right on its doorstep.

Auckland is defined by its harbour side location (often the city is referred to as 'The City of Sails') and the city spills down to meet it at Princes Wharf and The Viaduct. The central city has a relaxed Pacific vibe by day and a night time pulse that spreads across the surrounding suburbs. You can explore the city fringes full of character – Ponsonby and Parnell, full of stylish shops, cafes and restaurants. Auckland central is also home to a variety of attractions, including Auckland Art Museum (across the street from AUT), Auckland War Memorial Museum, the Sky Tower and its surrounding complex, the Voyager New Zealand Maritime Museum and Auckland Zoo.

Transportation and Parking Arrangements

Conference participants are asked to organise their own transfer to/from Auckland airport directly either with the hotel of their choice or by taxi upon arrival.

Reliable taxi services are available from Auckland Co-operative Taxis: 0800 300 3000 If you are driving to your accommodation, please enquire directly with the hotel about parking.

The Auckland University of Technology (AUT) AIMA Conference venue is within easy 5-15 minute walking distance from all accommodations suggested. For those with mobility issues, taxis are always available outside your hotel.

For those not staying in hotel arrangements, the <u>Civic Carpark</u> (entry at corner of Greys Ave and Mayoral Drive) or the <u>Victoria St Carpark</u> (30 Kitchener St, Auckland) are both a short walk from AUT. Otherwise paid <u>street parking</u> is available close to AUT - fees vary but most street parking in the vicinity can only be paid for 1-2 hours at a time and fines can be hefty.


